

#### POWYS NATIONAL GARDEN SCHEME

2024 was another landmark year for the National Garden Scheme with the charity donating a record £3,501,227 to some of the UK's best-loved nursing and health charities. The impact of these donations to our major nursing and health beneficiaries means thousands of people who live with health conditions such as cancer or Parkinson's, who have poor mental health, or who struggle financially as unpaid carers, have been supported by our funding of the nurses, health professionals and case workers who support them. Our funding also provides support to those in the Gardens and Health sector, to community gardens and to those working in horticulture. Our Community Garden Grants funded 89 new projects with a total of £232,000 in 2024. Four recipients were in Powys - Apple Blossom Social Enterprise CIC, £2,207; Cultivate (Cwm Harry) Cyfyngedig, £4,855; Senni Village Hall, £1,132 and The Fathom Trust, £2,580. The funding supports community allotments and gardens, rehabilitation and regeneration projects, as well as gardens designed to support mental health and wellbeing, and training and development for young people. The impact of this long-term commitment was celebrated in 2024 by our milestone of 40 years of continuous funding for Macmillan Cancer Support, during which time we gave more than £19.6 million.

Did you know we support Queen's Nurses from The Queen's Nursing Institute to run garden-related projects in their communities too? Since 2021, as part of the NGS Elsie Wagg (Innovation) Scholarship programme, we've supported 15 projects that have been changing lives. 



#### Llanwrtyd Wells Community Transport (LWCT)

LWCT provides a personal service to all our members requiring individual transport facilities to take them to medical appointments, shopping, taking much loved pets for treatment, taking them to visit friends and relatives and any other journey they would like to make. We also have a dedicated shopping service where we can shop for people who are unable to manage a trip to the shops themselves. Members can place their shopping order and our drivers shop and deliver. We can also collect and deliver prescriptions, pre ordered take away food, and offer assisted transport for whatever reason it is needed.

We have a disabled access vehicle making our service available to everyone. We make a point of assisting any member or business we can where based in our locality. We cover Llanwrtyd Wells, Abergwesyn, Cefn Gorwydd, Tirabad, Llangammarch Wells, Cilmery, Beulah, Garth and Llandrindod Wells and all surrounding villages.

The volunteers who cover our Volunteer Drivers Scheme either use their own car or ones belonging to LWCT. We also have a small fleet of minibuses available for hire by local community groups and other charities and not for profit organisations. These can be hired either with or without a driver, as long as conditions of hire are met.

LWCT is always happy to welcome enquiries about transport, if we can't help, we can signpost you to someone that can. We are also always happy to welcome new volunteers into the team, whether you want to become a driver, help with administrative duties or anything in between. Members, volunteers and paid staff are the heart of LWCT and by joining us you become part of a family.
