

## POWYS NATIONAL GARDEN SCHEME NEWS

We are sad to learn of the death of Dame Shân Legge-Bourke. Her home at Penmyarth House, Glanusk Estate near Crickhowell opened for the National Garden Scheme in 1952, until 2022; raising money for some of the UK's best-loved nursing and health charities through admissions, teas, cake and Estate Fayre. We send our condolences to the family.

Welcome to 2026 and a fabulous new year of great gardens to visit with the National Garden Scheme. Powys has 59 garden openings comprising 33 stand alone (five are new garden openings) and 26 in four village openings. Two of these villages are opening for the first time and two are returning after a gap last year with some new gardens.

After the dark days of winter spending time in a garden is proven to significantly improve wellbeing. Visitors feel more relaxed, happy, excited in the gardens and, not surprisingly, the more time visitors spend in winter gardens, the higher their wellbeing. 





## Llanwrtyd Wells Community Transport (LWCT)

LWCT provides a personal service to all our members requiring individual transport facilities to take them to medical appointments, shopping, taking much loved pets for treatment, taking them to visit friends and relatives and any other journey they would like to make. We also have a dedicated shopping service where we can shop for people who are unable to manage a trip to the shops themselves. Members can place their shopping order and our drivers shop and deliver. We can also collect and deliver prescriptions, pre ordered take away food, and offer assisted transport for whatever reason it is needed.

We have a disabled access vehicle making our service available to everyone. We make a point of assisting any member or business we can where based in our locality. We cover Llanwrtyd Wells, Abergwesyn, Cefn Gorwydd, Tirabad, Llangammarch Wells, Cilmerly, Beulah, Garth and Llandrindod Wells and all surrounding villages.

The volunteers who cover our Volunteer Drivers Scheme either use their own car or ones belonging to LWCT. We also have a small fleet of minibuses available for hire by local community groups and other charities and not for profit organisations. These can be hired either with or without a driver, as long as conditions of hire are met.

LWCT is always happy to welcome enquiries about transport, if we can't help, we can signpost you to someone that can. We are also always happy to welcome new volunteers into the team, whether you want to become a driver, help with administrative duties or anything in between. Members, volunteers and paid staff are the heart of LWCT and by joining us you become part of a family.






